### **Food N Stuff**

Food N Stuff is Trinity's student food and hygiene product pantry available to all students for free. It is located on the lower level of Mather next to the main stairwell. Food N Stuff is a collaboration between the Sustainability Office, the Office of Community Service and Civic Engagement, the Bantam Network, P.R.I.D.E., WGRAC, and the Office of International Students and Scholars.

A surprising amount of food insecurity exists on campus, especially during academic breaks. We invite Reunion attendees to help maintain Food N Stuff by bringing unopened, nonperishable foods and hygiene products for the pantry to the collection box at Reunion Headquarters in the Cave.

The most requested items include:

- Cereal
- Pasta and sauce
- Rice
- Trail mix
- Canned fruits
- Canned meats (Spam, tuna, etc.)
- Cooking oil sprays (olive, avocado, etc.)
- Multicultural foods
- Gluten-free foods
- Beverages
